### 16th ANNUAL COLON SCREENING FOR LIFE 5K RUN/WALK

Excluding skin cancers, colorectal cancer is the third most common cancer diagnosed in both men and women in the United States. The American Cancer Society's estimates for the number of colorectal cancer cases in the United States for 2024 are:

- 106,590 new cases of colon cancer (54,210 in men and 52,380 in women)
- 46,220 new cases of rectal cancer (27,330 in men and 18,890 in women)

The American Cancer Society (ACS) has guidelines for colorectal cancer screening and recommends people at average risk for colorectal cancer begin screening at age 45. In the most recent guideline update, ACS lowered the age to start screening because studies show rates of colorectal cancer among people younger than 50 are on the rise. If all adults 45 and older were screened for colorectal cancer we could avoid thousands of deaths each year and prevent many people from ever getting the disease.

For almost two decades, we at Colon Screening for Life along with our many other community sponsors have worked to increase the number of survivors by continuing to educate people on the importance of early detection and the prevention of colon cancer by regular screenings with events like the Colon Screening for Life 5K Run/Walk and 1 Mile Walk.

This year's Colon Screening for Life 5k event will be held on June 8, 2024 at Old National Bank, Downtown Evansville. #### **GUIDELINES FOR FORMING A TEAM**

- A team is a group of 5 or more individuals that sign up as a team to participate in the Colon Screening for Life 5k Run/Walk and 1 Mile Walk.
- Team must be formed by May 30th and have 5 or more people to participate in early packet pick-up. Any team members registered after May 30th will pick up packets individually day of the event.
- Team members can be any combination of runners, walkers, adults, and/or children.
- Each team must have a team name and an assigned team captain.
- Corporate sponsored teams of 20 or more participants will receive a 20% discount. Please contact Laurie Townsend for more information.

#### TEAM COMPETITION AND REWARDS

All team captains will go into a drawing to win a \$200.00 gift card. In addition, the team captain (excluding corporate sponsored teams) with the largest amount of participants will receive a trophy and a \$100 gift card.

#### REGISTRATION
